 Survey for Patricia Morrison Two Hundred  
 Acres of Land Situate Lying and  
 Being in North Carolina Washington  
 County on the Creek above the  
 Mouth of Coopers Creek Beginning  
 at a White Oak Near the Creek Running  
 North Thirty Six Degrees West fifty  
 Eight poles to a hickory Sapling in a flat

Thence North Seventy Degrees West one hundred and eighty four  
 poles to a White Oak on the side of a Ridge Thence South two  
 hundred and Eight poles to an Elm on the bank of the Creek Thence  
 East One hundred and sixty Eight poles to a Stake Thence North  
 twenty Seven Degrees East one hundred and twelve poles to the  
 Beginning containing Two hundred acres of Land divided by a  
 Scale of one hundred Equal parts to an Inch
